Bloodborne Pathogen Kits (Purell)

So, when would you use a Bloodborne Pathogen Kit?

A bloodborne pathogen kit should be used when dealing with potential exposure to blood or other bodily fluids that could contain infectious pathogens. This includes situations like cleaning up spills of blood or other potentially infectious materials, providing first aid to someone with an open wound, or in any scenario where there is a risk of contact with contaminated items.
